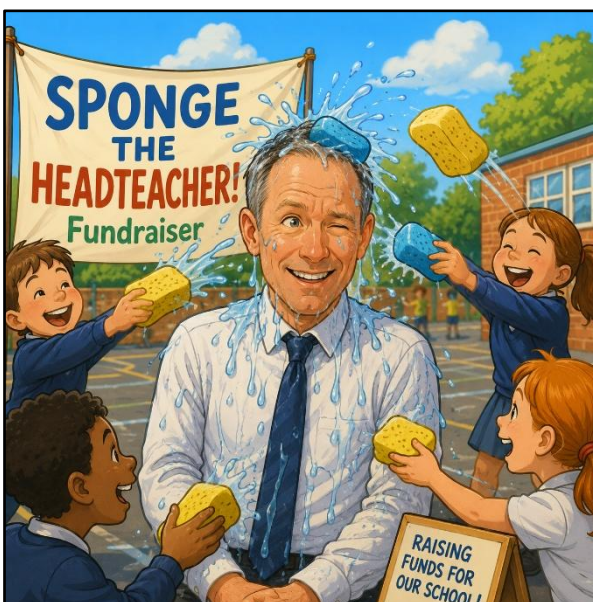
We hope you can support this event which will be on the yard straight after school.

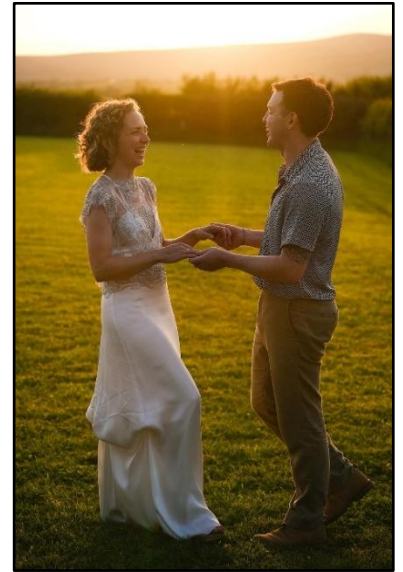
We're also looking out for someone to join our lunchtime play team. If you're interested, please see the attached advertisement and contact the school office with any questions.
