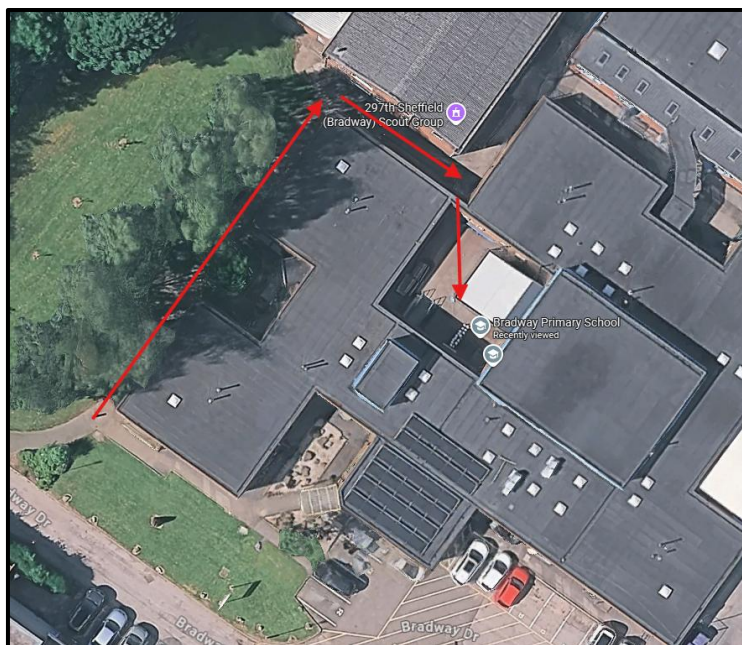
Transition Day
