World Environment Day

This week, a small group of Year 3 pupils — Lily, Imogen, Sophie and Theia — led a powerful and informative assembly to mark World Environment Day. They spoke confidently about endangered animals from around the world, including red pandas, Amur leopards, pygmy sloths, okapis, sea turtles, Javan rhinos and axolotls. The children shared fascinating facts about these creatures and explained how habitat destruction, poaching, pollution and climate change are threatening their survival. They also highlighted the importance of taking action — from reducing plastic use to making responsible choices about seafood and protecting natural environments. Their presentation included a short video featuring David Attenborough and ended with a strong message of hope: if we all make small changes, we can help protect our planet and its wildlife for future generations.
